

Eyes are windows into the soul, we've been told. But for now, it isn't safe to see each other face to face, not physically. As a congregation we've still gathered these past months, via the likes of Zoom. After dozens of committee and board meetings, Shabbat celebrations, and even a gala Fundraiser, I'm still struck by the experience of being together online. To see eyeto-eye, we need to see screen to screen. Our screens are windows into our homes.

In usual times, in our physical meetings, we self-present with clothing and posture. We bring our bodies, dressed up to impress, or dressed down to connect. We lean in or out; we create formality or intimach by whether and how we eat or drink;

we may take notes or do something with our hands. But for now, we also present our habitats, and our ways of being in

Though individual friendships and programs like "Dinner with a Stranger" have brought some of us into each other's homes, congregants mostly see each other at temple in usual times. But for now, we see beyond what people wear, into a small part of where people live. We wear our homes, dressing in the furniture and décor, art, books, plants...or the photo backdrops... we

Sometimes we multitask, and see each other in our kitchens; some of us dial in from cars. The setting may be a busy living room, a quiet bedroom, even an outdoor space. We can be pleasantly surprised by each other's children, pets, mates in the background; and we can share solitude. Sometimes, we ask others to look away by turning off our cameras; letting the voices and melodies do their work. Sometimes we look intently at each other's smiles, nods, thumbs up and even tears; mouthing along with muted singers. A Zoom Shabbat is part pantomime, part TV show, part theatrein-the-round. But it is all congregation, all windows into each other.

I'm eager to be back together physically when it's safe; I want to hear all the voices; I want the hugs to be more than virtual. But when we're back to wearing just our clothes, not our homes, something will be missing. One window will be closed, and we will have to look closer into each other's eyes.
